

HEALTH AND INSURANCE

NON-EUROPEAN UNION citizen

For students from other countries there are no official treaties ruling health care apart from national legislation. If this is your case, **you must take out an International Health Insurance which covers costs related to medical treatment and admission to hospital.** An insurance policy is compulsory if you apply for a residence permit.

You can also take out this insurance in Italy. This kind of insurance costs about € 150 for a period of 12 months, independently from your real period of stay. Please, ask for this Insurance to:
