Students regularly enrolled to: first cycle Degree courses (Bachelor), second cycle Degree courses (Master), third cycle Courses (PhD or residency programs)

### **SELECTION PROCEDURE**

The selection will be made according to the Erasmus + formula  
 $(0,7x M) + (0,3x R) \times 30$

Where:

M = weighted average number, as recorded on ESSE3 system, at the deadline of the Erasmus + Call;

R = earned credits, as recorded on ESSE3 system, at the deadline of the of the Erasmus + Call except AP activities; / credits needed for the first semester of enrollment year, as reported in the Student's guide;

R factor Numerator (achieved credits) is the sum of all earned credits as recorded on the career at the deadline of the Erasmus + Call;

Denominator of R factor (needed credits for the first semester of the enrollment year), examples:

- For a student enrolled in the first year of a degree course, the denominator factor R will correspond to half of the number credits needed for the first year
- For a student enrolled in the second year of a degree course, the denominator factor R will correspond to the sum of the number credits needed for the first year, plus the half of the number credits needed for the second year.

Grades or credits achieved after the deadline will not be considered.





For all exams passed and not yet registered in the system, please, ask the involved teachers to record the votes.

### **FINANCIAL SUPPORT**

Erasmus grant is composed of one or two of the following items:

- an EU monthly contribution;
- a monthly contribution from the University.

Regarding the EU monthly contribution, The Ministry of Education , University and Research established for the academic year 2015/2016 the following amounts:
